STILL WATERS BREVARD- UNDER WHOLENESS TO FREEDOM MINISTRIES, IS A TRANSITIONAL, EDUCATIONAL AND TRANSFORMATIONAL PROGRAM THAT DELIVERS NECESSARY SERVICES TO SINGLE WOMEN AND SINGLE MOTHERS, WHO FIND THEMSELVES IN UNSTABLE, HOMELESS, AND TRANSITIONAL SITUATIONS. IT IS NOT A TEMPORARY SHELTER, BUT AN INTENSIVE CHRIST-CENTERED PROGRAM FOR WOMEN DESIRING GROWTH AND PERMANENT CHANGE IN THEIR LIVES. WE ARE NOT A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE OR ADDICTION RECOVERY SHELTER, BUT RATHER A LIFE SCHOOL WITH THE GRADUATE GOAL BEING THAT OF: STABILITY, HEALTH, HEALING, CAREER AND FINANCIAL INDEPENDENCE.

1. SERVICES WE PROVIDE

- ☐ A multi-phase Christ-centered educational program, that includes opportunities for education, food, safety, life skills development, Christian discipleship, financial literacy, and mental health counseling. This is done through classes, counseling, educating and equipping. We provide a safe environment with necessary resources to support women in healing, learning life skills, and implementing life-long healthy decisions.
- ☐ Shared housing while participating in the program -up through graduation.
- ☐ On site counseling services, weekly bible study classes, financial and goals planning, a multi-faceted course curriculum.
- ☐ Case management to assist in reaching goals, obtaining resources, education, financial and medical services.
- ☐ Access to partner organizations for resources, housing assistance, and food pantries.
- ☐ Assistance in obtaining resources for higher education/certifications/employment. Job readiness, interviewing and resume building classes.
- ☐ A safe, healthy, trauma informed care environment, centered around each individual and their needs.

2. SOME OF OUR REQUIREMENTS

- ☐ Drug, Alcohol and Tobacco free campus. Random drug/alcohol testing is consistently active. No visitors on campus- unless pre-approved for every student's safety.
- ☐ Ongoing commitment to participate in the Still Waters Brevard program, including but not limited to: classes, counseling, case management, medical provider appointments. Homework assignments completed weekly.
- ☐ No romantic relationships while enrolled in the program, allowing each student to focus on their healing, goals, mental health and future.
- ☐ Still Waters Brevard supports single women in their healing and in becoming healthy, while they work to obtain the goal of being financially independent. Students must actively participate in financial literacy and work with their case manager to obtain their individual goals.

3. INTAKE PROCESS

- ☐ Complete an application: (found online at: www.wholenesstofreedom.org) or request an email application or request an application in person.
- ☐ Upon receipt of the application, a phone call will be scheduled to speak with you.
- ☐ If an individual initially qualifies for the program, an in-person interview will be set up with the SWB Program Coordinator.
- ☐ Upon completion of the interview- it will be determined by both the candidate and program if the intake process should proceed.
- ☐ Once all steps are complete- and if mutually agreed that Still Waters Brevard is a fit for the candidate, the candidate will work with the SWB Case Manager to complete their intake and move in process.
- ☐ Intake paperwork will occur prior to moving onto the Still Waters Brevard campus, and a case manager will be assigned to assist each student.
